# CONDITIONS FOR GROUPS FROM UNIVERSITIES, ACADEMIC CENTRES AND AGENCIES

# GROUP PROGRAMMES

The UIMP organises, curates and runs specific academic programmes in Spain for Spanish as a foreign language courses aimed at teenagers (minimum admission age: 16), university students (accredited curricular stays) and lifelong professional training (international companies and organisations).

The UIMP is an Instituto Cervantes Accredited Centre for teaching Spanish as a Foreign Language. This certification means the centre complies with the conditions set by the Instituto Cervantes Centre Accreditation System (SACIC)—the only international certification focussed exclusively on teaching Spanish as a foreign language.

In addition, university students and professionals can, in summer, follow a more comprehensive programme of Spanish language and culture with workshops, lectures, meetings and seminars that cover up-to-date topics with a standout scientific, social and humanities slant as part of the Advanced UIMP Courses at La Magdalena Palace (Santander).

If you represent an overseas university, institution, company or agency and would like to arrange a training programme with the UIMP that adapts to the requirements of your group, we offer three different possibilities in Santander and at other UIMP campuses:

- 1. Incorporating your group onto scheduled courses.
- 2. Programming one of our existing courses on dates that suit your group.
- 3. Designing a specific training programme for your university, institution or company that matches your requirements.

The UIMP issues certificates in ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).

# **1.- CONDITIONS FOR GROUPS**

# A.- STUDENTS-REGISTRATION

The UIMP will offer group discounts by way of free registration in line with the following ratios:

- 15-20 enrolled students: 1 free registration
- 30-50 enrolled students: 2 free registration

# **B.- GROUP TUTOR**

# - Food and board

- One-week course: The Universidad Internacional Menéndez Pelayo (hereinafter the UIMP) offers lecturers/tutors with a minimum of 15 enrolled students **free board** at university halls of residence.
- Two to four-week course: The UIMP offers lecturers/tutors with a minimum of 15 enrolled students free food and board at university halls of residence.

## 2.- AGENCY CONDITIONS

The UIMP will provide a 15-20% discount on registration to agencies or agents who apply for it (upon signature of the corresponding accreditation agreement), as long as at least ten students enrol.

- 10-29 students: 15%
- 30-50 students: 20%

This discount can be used for Spanish language and culture courses and for specialised teacher courses overseas.

The UIMP will consider proposed specific agreements between institutions where different conditions to those set out in this document are established.

## ACCOMMODATION

## 1.- Residence - Las Llamas Campus

Classes are taught here.

Services: Single or double rooms with ensuite bathroom, and rooms offering disabled access.

The campus offers: a library, cafeteria, dining room, study rooms, computer rooms, kitchen, laundry service and self-service laundrette, parking, green spaces and sports facilities. 24h reception.

In addition to the Campus sports facilities (gym, tennis and basketball court), by showing their UIMP ID, students enjoy special rates at a private sports facility facing the Campus (pool, sauna, gym, fitness classes...).

# 2.- Stables Residence (La Magdalena Peninsula)

The residence is located on La Magdalena peninsula, where the Palace is also situated and where the summer courses on specific topics are run (Humanities, Social Sciences, Science and Technology...).

Services: Double rooms with ensuite bathroom and rooms offering disabled access. The residence offers a university dining hall, cafeteria, laundry service, Wi-Fi area, parking, landscaped patio and outdoor gardens.
