The residence is located on the campus where the Spanish Summer Courses are taught. There are single and double rooms available. Adapted for those with a disability. 24-hour reception.



Registration and Enrolment

Required Documentation

Students who wish to register must fill in the form available at the following link:

And submit it alongside the following documentation:

- A photocopy of your passport
- For under-18s, the permission form signed by the student's parents or legal guardians

Payment Deadline

Once the Secretary's Office receives the preregistration application, students will be sent a budget, as well as instructions on how to pay the enrolment fees. Where you have requested accommodation in the halls of residence, this will also be included in the budget.

The course and registration fees must be paid after the budget is issued and the place confirmed. Applicants will have 10 days to make the corresponding payment.



Payment Methods

All bank fees must be covered by students.

B. Payment **may also be made by credit card**. Where students wish to use this payment option, they must specifically notify the Secretary's Office so as to enable access to online payments.



Level Tests

After picking up their ID from the Secretary's Office, students must sit a level test on their first day in order to allocate them to **the most suitable group** for their level and requirements

Attendance Certificate

Students will receive an attendance certificate at the end of their course, in accordance with the **European Common Framework of Reference (ECFR)**, stating the level and class load.

In order to be awarded the certificate, students must attend **at least 85% of the Spanish Language** and Culture classes, taking into account the class hours stated in the corresponding information table and as per the period of stay for courses.



Students with Disabilities or Special Educational Needs

Students with a physical, mental or sensory disability, or who have special educational needs, must notify the university before booking a course, so that the centre may advise them about the suitability of the selected course

Cancellation, Withdrawal and Refunds

A. Course cancellation: where the university cancels a course or level, students will be fully reimbursed, both for tuition and admin fees. Where students so request, they may use the amount for another course scheduled in the same academic year

B. Enrolment cancellation: in the event that students wish to withdraw their enrolment on a course and in order to be refunded, they must make their request to **alumnos.devoluciones@uimp.es** before the start of the course, providing the reason for said cancellation and attaching the relevant supporting documents





Enrolment withdrawal requests shall be processed as per the following deadlines and amounts:

- Cancellation or withdrawal requests submitted seven calendar days before the start of the course will receive a 100% refund for tuition fees
- Enrolment cancellation or withdrawal requests submitted less than seven calendars before the start of the course will receive a 75% refund for tuition fees
- No refunds will be paid from the day the course starts.

Instances of force majeure will be analysed on an individual basis after submission of official supporting documents.

The registration admin fee (\in 22.50) shall not be refunded where students request cancellation.

All requests must be made on the official form available on the university website and be sent to the following e-mail: **alumnos.devoluciones@uimp.es**

Visas

European Union citizens do not require a visa to attend the courses.

Non-EU citizens must consult their nearest embassy or consulate regarding any requirements to study in Spain.

Students who request a UIMP admission document to process a visa application at Spanish embassies or consulates must have paid the full fees for their selected course beforehand. **The admission document will be sent once payment is received**. The document will contain students' personal details, ID or passport number, the period where they will take the UIMP courses and the accommodation address for their stay.

Where visas are denied, the UIMP will refund the course fees, provided that students notify the university by the relevant date and method, and attach the document issued by the embassy or consulate notifying them of the visa refusal and the explanation for it.
