CONDITIONS FOR AGENCIES AND AGENTS

The Menéndez Pelayo International University (hereinafter, UIMP) organizes, designs, and delivers specialized academic programs in Spanish for international students in Spain. These programs are intended for high school students (minimum admission age: 16), university students (accredited curricular stays), and professionals seeking continuing education (companies and international organizations).

The UIMP is an Accredited Center by the Cervantes Institute (Instituto Cervantes) for the teaching of Spanish as a Foreign Language. This accreditation certifies that the university meets the standards established by the Cervantes Institute Accreditation System for Centers (SACIC), the only international accreditation focused exclusively on Spanish as a foreign language.

Additionally, during the summer, university students and professionals may enroll in a more comprehensive program that combines Spanish language and culture classes with workshops, master classes, lectures, and seminars addressing current topics of scientific, social, and humanistic interest, within the UIMP Advanced Courses held at the Magdalena Palace in Santander.

The UIMP issues certifications in the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

Enrollment in UIMP courses may be completed individually, at the request of the participant, or collectively through an agent or agency requesting group enrollment in one or more courses offered by the UIMP.

CONDITIONS FOR AGENCIES

Agencies or agents are eligible for a discount of 15% to 20% on tuition fees (upon signing the corresponding accreditation agreement) for groups of at least 10 students:

10 to 29 students: 15% discount30 to 50 students: 20% discount

These discounts also apply to Spanish language and culture courses and teacher specialization programs abroad.

ACCOMMODATION - "Campus de Las Llamas" Residence Hall

Services: Single and double rooms with private bathrooms, accessible rooms for students with disabilities, library, cafeteria, dining hall, study rooms, computer labs, kitchen, laundry facilities (self-service and staffed), parking, green areas, sports facilities, and 24-hour reception. Additional sports facilities include a gym and tennis and basketball courts.
