Each student is assigned a director of the Master's Thesis (Thesis) that collaborates in the identification of the research topic and continuously monitors its development.

During the preparation of the thesis, the students make two presentations to the teachers and the rest of the students of the Master. The first takes place in February and consists of a presentation of the initial draft. In the second, which in May, students present the first results of the research.

The defense of the Master's Thesis takes place in a public session in June. A week after that event, the students submit their work, which is evaluated by the director and another teacher of the CEMFI, and which is then graded at a meeting of the faculty of the CEMFI.
